The Institute of Clerks of Works and Construction Inspectorate (ICWCI) held its 10<sup>th</sup> Building on Quality Awards Luncheon at Wimbledon's All England Lawn Tennis Club, London on Thursday 26th November 2009. Principal Guest was Graham Watts OBE, Chief Executive of the Construction Industry Council.

Awards were made in four categories – Civil Engineering, Refurbishment, New Build/Refurbishment and New Build. From 28 short-listed entries from the UK, Ireland, Guernsey and the Isle of Man, Les Howard MICWCI of Anthony Reddy Associates Architects picked up the 'Overall Winner Award' for his involvement with the New Eircom Headquarters in Heuston South Quarter, Dublin.
